Motion by Turnwald, seconded by Beltinck to have staff secure architectural design services and solicit for proper financing to fund the construction of a new Mt. Pleasant facility replacing the current Isabella County Road Commission building which has served the community since 1952. The Manager informed the Commissioners that the Lincoln Road Bridge is behind schedule due to all the flooding the rain has caused.

Commissioner Turnwald said that the parks overall revenue and number of registrations are still up from last year. He also explained that 40 trees have been cut down in the parks. Commissioner Graham said that he has talked to the owners of Pohls Market and they are very unhappy with the road being shut down during Memorial Weekend.
